WELCOME

We are inviting primary schools, nurseries and community groups in Glasgow to get creative and join the community and learning programme of Scotties in the City, which is coming to Glasgow in summer 2026.

This is a chance for your school, nursery or community group be part of a fantastic feel-good event that will showcase your organisation's creative talent and involve you in this exciting, community-wide project.

WHAT IS SCOTTIES IN THE CITY?

For eight weeks in summer 2026, a pack of giant Scottie sculptures, each sponsored by a local business and painted uniquely by an artist, will take over Glasgow. They'll be joined by 60 smaller Scotties, each individually designed as part of the community and learning programme.

The Scotties in the City trail will contribute to the social, cultural and economic growth of Glasgow by attracting visitors to our vibrant city. The large Scotties will be placed strategically in streets, parks and public spaces. The small Scotties will be placed

securely indoors in cultural, leisure and retail venues; transforming our community into an open-air gallery that brings joy to all who visit.

After the trail, the small Scotties will be returned to you to keep as a lasting legacy, and the large sculptures will then be sold at auction to raise much needed funds for Maggie's across Scotland.

We need you to make this trail PAWsome! We have a limited number of Scotties available for schools, nurseries and community groups to be involved in this exciting initiative and so get in touch and reserve your Scottie today.

OUR COMMUNITY AND LEARNING PROGRAMME

Your young people, or group members, will become platformed artists in your local area. Your small Scottie will be showcased in one of Glasgow's cultural or retail hotspots, ready to be admired by friends, family and thousands of visitors!

We are inviting primary schools, nurseries and community groups across Glasgow to take part in our community and learning programme by adopting a small Scottie.

EACH PARTICIPATING GROUP WILL RECEIVE

- An invitation to join our community and learning programme workshop with Wild in Art. At this event we will give you guidance on how to get your group involved and top tips on bringing your Scottie to life
- A blank small Scottie sculpture to decorate and design
- A resource pack full of engaging activities, fundraising ideas and helpful tips to create your Scottie
- A plaque next to your sculpture with your group logo and information about the inspiration behind your group's design





When the small Scotties have been decorated, they will join the large Scotties and, together they will form a magnificent sculpture trail around Glasgow for eight weeks.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

Register now and secure your own small Scottie. You have until Friday 28 November to sign up for Scotties in the City. There are only a small number of sculptures available and to take part your school or group **must be based within a Glasgow postcode area.**

ADOPTION FEE: £375

There is a minimum of £375 adoption fee and fundraising pledge to secure your Scottie. Our team can support you with fundraising ideas. By adopting a small Scottie, you're helping us to raise vital funds for Maggie's across Scotland.




- An information pack with all that you need to make the most of your Scotties in the City sculpture

ABOUT YOUR SCOTTIE

The small Scotties are made of fire-resistant fibreglass and will come to you as a ready-to-paint primed white 3D canvas. They are robust and hardwearing and weigh approximately 8kg.

It's measurements are H 74.5cm, W 32cm, L 90cm.

Let us know that you'd like to join our pack of Scotties by emailing scotties@maggies.org. We will then make sure that you have everything you need including fundraising and learning resources.


STEP 2
